JUNE 16	<u>Plant and Grow</u> by Cottage Door Press - Plant life cycles, agriculture, following directions.	Students will create their own greenhouse to observe the growth of plants.
JUNE 23	<u>Edible Colors: See, Learn, Eat</u> by Jennifer Vogel Bass - Agriculture, nutrition, colors, sorting skills	Students will sort pictures of fruits and veggies into color categories using a <u>Garden Color Sort</u> printable activity.
JUNE 30	<u>Little Sunflower</u> by Autumn Publishing - Plant Science, life cycles, social skills, listening skills.	Students will decorate a pot and plant a sunflower seed to observe at home.
JULY 7	<u>Sunflower House</u> by Eve Bunting - Plant Science, art, listening skills.	Students will construct flowers using household items.
JULY 14	<u>Who's in the Barn?</u> by Megan Roth & <u>Farm Peekaboo</u> by DK Publishing Literature, listening skills, vocabulary	Students will play a "Guess Who's Hiding Game" using farm animals.
JULY 21	<u>Little Blue Truck</u> by Alice Schertle Literature, Animal Science, Sorting, Art, Listening Skills	Students will make a mud painting with the characters from the story.
JULY 28	<u>Spookly the Square Pumpkin</u> by Joe Troiano Literature, Plant Science, Life Cycles, Shapes	Students will create their very own pumpkin patch using shapes of their choosing.
